Material	Something that an object is made from
Continents	Continents are made up of countries and there are seven in the world – Asia, Africa, South America, North America, Australasia, Antarctica, and Europe.
Oceans	A big sea and there are 5 in the world – Indian, Pacific, Southern, Atlantic, Artic.
Climate	The weather in a certain place
Town	A place where people live that is bigger than a village.
Village	A place where people live that is found in the countryside
Landscape	What you can see when you look out over an area of land
Factory	A building where people make things with machines
Farm	Land where someone grows plants or keeps animals.
Crops	Plants grown on a farm

<u>Where is Egypt?</u> Egypt is a country in Africa which is surrounded by the Mediterranean sea . The capital is Cairo . It is a very hot climate as it is near to the equator .		
<u>Where is Langley?</u> Langley is a small town in the West Midlands. It is a town with lots of factories . It has a high street with a supermarket, library, park and the church. Everything is close by and within walking distance.
