We would like to express our sincere gratitude to the Singlepoint team for their dedicated support and collaboration over the years.

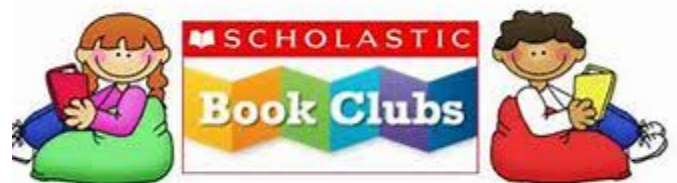
